General Guidelines (not required)

Use a PowerPoint slide to design your poster.

Keep text short

Use one font style - No crazy or “fun” fonts

Use consistent font sizes for titles/subtitles

- Titles: no smaller than 30 pt font size
- Text: no smaller than 20 pt front size

Use clean graphics - Search “royalty free images” for high-quality images

Use contrasting text and background for better readability

Research Focused Posters must include the following:

A description of the participant(s), the procedure or intervention, and results.

A graphic or tabular summary of obtained data

Research-focused posters without a supporting graph or table will be rejected.

- The data do not need to be complete at time of submission, but the submission form must state that the project is well under way.
- Follow [APA Style](#) to format graphs or tables

- Your submission is acceptance of responsibility. If your submission is accepted, the presenting author(s) will have to register for and attend the conference.
